HEARING OFFICERS

Hearing Officers are University Administrators that hear disciplinary cases. One or two Administrators will be present during the hearing. Hearings generally take between one to two hours depending on the incident in question and the extent of the resident's involvement. During the hearing, the resident will be given a copy of the Information Report for them to review. The resident will then have a chance to respond to the information contained within the Information Report and present witnesses. After all parties have presented their information and finished with questioning, the Hearing Officers will decide if the student was "Responsible" or "Not Responsible" for a violation of University and/or Housing policy and assign appropriate sanctions if applicable. When deciding sanctions, Hearing Officers will consider any previous disciplinary action brought against the resident.
