



Residence Hall Move In Packing List

Here's a list of items for you to consider as you plan your move to UCSB!

- Cell phone and charger
- Alarm clock, desk lamp, small fan
- TV limit 32", IPOD, camera
- Computer, hardware for hookup, metal surge protector or electrical strip, heavy duty extension cord, computer cord and computer lock (www.housing.ucsb.edu/resnet/default.htm for information)
- Printer (optional) and supplies (ink and paper, etc.)
- Desk supplies such as stapler, staples, paper clips, push pins, pens, pencils, notebooks, message board
- Bike and bike lock (attach lock to bike at home, don't pack it or you'll not find it when you need it!)
- Refrigerator, largest size permitted is 4.5 cu. ft. (no cooking equipment allowed!)
- Snack kit...salt / pepper, spoon, fork, knife, napkins, small paper plates, bowl, coffee mug and paper towels
- Laundry bag and laundry detergent
- Iron, ironing board and clothes hangers
- Towels, washcloths, flip-flops / shower sandals
- Case to carry toiletry items to the showers
- Toiletries such as soap, deodorant, toothpaste, mouthwash, shampoos, conditioner, razor, brush and comb, sunblock, other necessary medications & prescriptions
- Bedding, blankets, comforter, pillows, pillow cases, flat and fitted extra long twin sheets, mattress pad
- Under bed storage containers (our beds are adjustable so no need to bring risers)
- Beach towel and / or beach chair
- Sleeping bag for guests
- Back pack
- Small first aid kit, flashlight and batteries, emergency glow sticks
- Decorative items (most of the Residence Hall rooms have a wall with fabric-like surface so you may use push pins to put up posters, etc.)

******Residence Halls have microwaves available for your use in common areas. Absolutely no cooking appliances are allowed in the student rooms!**

******Closet space is limited so select the items you bring carefully, remember you are sharing space with one or two roommates.**

******Pack wisely! Use wheeled suitcases and sturdy, closed packing boxes (Uhaul, etc). We recommend that you bring a hand cart, dolly or wagon to move belongings from the unloading areas to your room. A small tool kit with screwdrivers and a rubber mallet would also be helpful if you choose to change the configuration of the furniture in your room.**
